FRESH FOOD FOR THOSE WHO SERVE(D)

This fall, we're recognizing the veterans and active service members in our community, many of whom rely on Foodbank distributions and deliveries for fresh produce and healthy grocery staples. We will be providing fresh produce at the 9th Annual Santa Barbara County Veterans Stand Down event on October 16, as well as honoring service members and veterans at both Santa Maria and Santa Barbara Empty Bowls events this November! Here are two stories from local veterans:

"Laura" is a local veteran living in Lompoc, CA. She and her husband both served for 31 years, and have been getting by with nutritious food from the Foodbank. Her husband is very sick and can't keep anything down, so Victoria has a hard time supporting him. The Foodbank is one of the only services that actually helps, she said. At the end of a call with a Foodbank staff member, she said "God bless you."

"Hank" is a Korean War veteran living with his daughter in Santa Barbara. They get a home delivery of groceries from the Foodbank every other week—he said he gives whatever they don't eat to his neighbor, who is also a veteran. "Support is hard to come by these days," he said. "We do what we can with what we've got—we're thankful for the Foodbank, more than you know."

White Bean and Veggie Salad

This fresh, fall salad combines creamy, delicious white beans and avocado. You can mix it up with different seasonal vegetables to create a new recipe each time you make it. Thanks to Katie at EatingWell.com for the recipe!

Ingredients

2 cups mixed salad greens

³/₄ cup veggies of your choice, such as chopped cucumbers and cherry tomatoes

1/3 cup canned white beans, rinsed and drained

½ avocado, diced

1 tablespoon red-wine vinegar

2 teaspoons extra-virgin olive oil

¼ teaspoon kosher salt

Freshly ground pepper to taste

Instructions

Combine greens, veggies, beans and avocado in a medium bowl. Drizzle with vinegar and oil and season with salt and pepper. Toss to combine and transfer to a large plate
