BUILDING READINESS: CAMPAIGN FOR A HUNGER-FREE TOMORROW

Our new Santa Barbara facility is more than a warehouse—it's a Sharehouse. A place to share food, nutrition education and hope, with critically needed services for our most vulnerable community members.

With a 57,000-square-foot warehouse and 20,000 square-feet of office space, the Sharehouse will enable us to distribute more healthy food more efficiently; store sufficient food for disasters; and house a Nutrition Promotion Center.

Our current Santa Barbara warehouse can only hold 15% of food needed for south county. Most food is stored in Santa Maria and trucked south daily.

The Sharehouse will dramatically increase capacity countywide by allowing both our Santa Maria and Santa Barbara facilities to store enough food for each end of the county, without the cost and emissions produced by daily transport.

As always, dedicated community members like you are critical to best fight hunger here at home. The Sharehouse will serve our entire county—neighbors, children, friends and families—for decades to come.

Your support will equip county residents in need to create a stronger tomorrow and will help all of us be resilient in case of disasters.

YOUR NUTRITION

Chiles Rellenos / Stuffed Peppers

Looking for an easy, tasty and nutritious meal? Check out this quick, plant-based option from our Healthy School Pantry Program!

Serves: 4 | Time: 30 minutes

Ingredients

- 4 poblano peppers
- 2 potatoes
- 2 carrots
- 1 zucchin
- Salt / Pepper
- Accompaniment
- Brown rice, beans
- Avocado, salad

nstructions

- 1. Wash the peppers. Roast "on the fire" either on your stove or a grill. When the skins are black, place the peppers in a plastic bag to "sweat" so you can peel them easily.
- 2. Wash and chop the vegetables into small cubes. Cook the potatoes in a little oil in a skillet over medium-high heat. Once the potatoes are soft, add the zucchini and carrots. Season to taste with salt and pepper.
- 3. Slice open your peppers and fill them with the vegetables.
- 4. Serve with rice, avocado, salad or beans.
